Deb's Amazing Cheese Dip

Ingredients

8 oz. Philadelphia Cream Cheese
(I use Neufchatel - it's the lite cream cheese)

Spread cheese on the bottom of glass Pyrex dish

1 small can of diced green chilies spread on top of cream cheese

1 can of Hormel Chili - no beans spread on top

1.5 cups of shredded cheddar cheese (or the Mexican 4 cheese shredded blend)

Preparation

Bake in oven at 300 degrees until melted - about 10 minutes

Serve with restaurant style tortilla chips
